

Course in Private Native Forestry

You are invited to attend training in the management and harvesting of native forest on private property. This will improve your skills and understanding of the Private Native Forestry Code of Practice.

OVERVIEW

This brochure describes how those working in private native forest can gain the skills and knowledge to better understand the obligations associated with sustainable harvesting under a Private Native Forestry Property Vegetation Plan. It is being run by TAFE and the Department of Environment and Climate Change (DECC).

WHO SHOULD DO THIS TRAINING?

All forestry contractors and crew as well as private native forest landholders who do their own forestry operations.

WHY SHOULD I DO THIS TRAINING?

If you are involved in harvesting private native forests, you are responsible for complying with the Private Native Forestry Code of Practice. This training will show you what you have to do to comply with the Code.

WHAT IF I DON'T DO IT NOW?

At the moment the DECC is covering most of the costs for this training, however when this ends, it would cost you at least \$1000 to complete all the required units. If you do the training now it will only cost you \$45 for each 2-day session, which is tax deductible if you work in the industry.

WHAT DOES THE TRAINING COVER?

Three main components of the course in Private Native Forestry are currently being offered which cover the key elements of the Code:

Forest Soil and Water Protection – covering best practice techniques for the protection of the soil and water qualities of the forest.

Silviculture - gives you an introduction to how forests should be managed to improve timber supply into the future.

Biodiversity Protection - shows you how you can protect native plants, animals and habitats in the forests where you work.

WILL THIS GIVE ME A QUALIFICATION?

When you successfully complete the units mentioned above you will receive a Transcript towards a Statement of Attainment in Sustainable Private Native Forestry.

HOW DO I ENROL?

These courses are being delivered through the TAFE Forest Industry Training Centre - please use the attached Registration Form to express your interest in attending training. For enquiries, please contact Sue Wassink on 02 6981 4806. Please do this as soon as possible to make sure you get a place on the course in your closest town. You will need to pay the \$45 straight away to keep the place for you. If you enrol 4 people or more, you only need to pay \$40 per person.

PAYMENT METHODS

The preferred payment method is by credit card over the phone. Alternatively you can pay via cheque, or money order at the time of confirming attendance (please see attached Registration and Payment Form).

HELP WITH TRAVEL

There is a subsidy available for people who complete the two-day training sessions and who live more than 30km from the venue. You could be eligible for between \$42 and \$140 travel payment (per family). Claims can be made after the training has been completed.
